Skateboarding

Skateboarding sessions at the Village Hall car park will resume on three Saturday mornings in March (10th, 17th, 24th) from 11.00 until 1.00. The Waddesdon Local Area Forum of Bucks County Council has agreed to cover the cost of 32 two-hour sessions from April onwards. Council is now applying for grants from AVDC's New Homes Bonus and from the Hine Memorial Trust to cover the cost of the ramps/equipment and a storage box/shed at the Hall.

Speeding

The Sentinel camera sessions will resume when the weather improves. The Waddesdon Local Area Forum of Bucks County Council has agreed to pay 50% of the cost of assessing the need for a lower speed limit (20mph) in Castle Street, to slow down traffic in the vicinity of Marsh School.

HGV Weight Limit

Council has requested Transport for Buckinghamshire to consider a weight limit on HGVs using the village as a route to their destinations elsewhere.
