## <u>Planning</u>

- At its recent meeting Council had no objection to application 19/04427/LBP for internal and external alterations to 5 Acland Terrace, OX27 0ES.
- AVDC has recently approved: 19/03906/APP to replace the stolen lead on St Mary's Church roof with steel; 19/03611/ACL for 49 Little Marsh Road; 19/01227/APP for Lanes End Barn; and 19/03522/APP for Charndon Grounds.
- AVDC refused application 19/03519/APP for an extension and garage at Stableyard Cottage, Blackthorn Road, OX27 0AG.
- Preliminary works appear to be underway at Ewelme Sites B and C.

# **Church Street Closure**

Thames Water's contractors were due to begin work on Monday 3rd, resulting in the closure of Church Street for about 19 days.

### Precept for 2020-21

Council has agreed to precept £25,000 to cover its outgoings next year; £500 more (1.9%) than the current year.

### HGVs in the Village

For over a year Council has been seeking to obtain the data to enable a weight limit to be imposed on HGVs using the village as a route to other places – especially given the dangers of West Edge without a pavement. Two weeks ago, the County Council installed a traffic counter across the road in Church Street, to measure the number of HGVs passing over it. Thames Valley Police are also being consulted on the options and enforcement if a weight limit is imposed. A decision may be available this spring.

#### **Skateboarding**

The target to raise £5,309 by March 1<sup>st</sup> only needs another £137. This will pay for new equipment and a year's weekly ramp sessions for youngsters at the Hall on Sunday afternoons. Thanks to the generosity of residents and local businesses, with donations from AVDC, the Hine Trust and Parish Council, £5,172 has already been promised. If you could make a small donation to get the project over the line, simply go online to the Spacehive website (<u>www.spacehive.com</u>) and search for 'Keep Our Kids On Wheels In Marsh Gibbon' where you will be asked to 'Back this project'.

#### **Cemetery Improvement**

Work on relaying the internal paths has begun and should take about six weeks. During this period, the cemetery will only be open to the public from 3:30 pm, Monday to Friday, until dusk. It will also be open from 1:30 pm on Saturdays and all day on Sundays. Members of the public will be permitted to be in the cemetery during a burial. The Parish Council apologises for any inconvenience this might cause. The work is entirely funded by a grant from the AVDC New Homes Bonus scheme.

#### **Parish Council Elections**

Elections for the seven-person Council will be held on May 7th. Anyone interested in standing is welcome to discuss the role with a current councillor and to attend the February 11<sup>th</sup> and March 10<sup>th</sup> council meetings to find out what is involved. The closing date for nominations is April 8<sup>th.</sup>
