AVDC Development Management Committee has approved outline planning permission for the field opposite School, for up to 10 dwellings, retail premises and parking for school and shop. Conditions such as landscaping and a S106 agreement will now be agreed by the Committee. There will then be a detailed planning application by whoever acquires the site from Ewelme for development. All the members who had been on the site visit voted to overturn the officers' recommendation for refusal. It will still be several months before any work commences.
