1 APOLOGIES

2 DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

None.

3 MINUTES OF MEETING HELD ON 9 AUGUST 2022

The minutes of the meeting held on 9 August were agreed by those present and signed by the Chairman. Note: the September meeting was cancelled in respect to HM Queen Elizabeth II period of mourning.

4 MATTERS ARISING

There were no Matters Arising.

5 PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

Chair welcomed the resident and invited him to speak after the Clerk's Report (see 9 below).

6 GENERAL CORRESPONDENCE

All correspondence had been circulated to Councillors.

Appendix 1.

- 6.1 Councillors had received an email from the Local Area Technician requesting permission to plant 5-6 trees at the following locations:
 - Site 1) Verge outside village hall (Possibly 2 trees)
 - Site 2) Verge opposite north end of Wales Lane near notice board (Possibly 2-3 trees)
 - Site 3) Verge in Swan Lane outside number 5 (Possibly 1-2 trees)

Councillors did not want any trees planted on the verge outside the village hall but the other two locations were considered to be possibilities plus near the all weather pitch, behind the village hall to replace some vandalised a couple of years ago. However, before confirming any sites Councillors would like a site meeting with the LAT to discuss locations and types of trees.

Action: Clerk to write to LAT to organise site meeting.

6.2 Speed watch

Cllr TR reported that he had set up approved locations for speedwatch but still needed volunteers

Action: Cllr NL to put note on Facebook and Cllr JS to ask that a request for volunteers is included in the school newsletter.

7 PLANNING

7.1 Planning applications

22/02941/ALB | Listed building application for formation of en-suite | The Croft West Edge Marsh Gibbon Councillors had no objection to this planning application. [Note: this application has now been withdrawn] **22/02845/APP** | Erection of single temporary dwelling | Newpond Farm Twyford To Marsh Gibbon Road Councillors did not wish to comment on this as it was not in Marsh Gibbon.

It was noted that the Parish Council had not been consulted on the above variations.

7.3 **Late Notifications** – to review any applications issued after the publication of the Parish Council agenda: There were no late notifications to consider.

7.4 **Ewelme Sites** – to receive updates on Sites A and B

7.4.1 Site A

It was noted that:

- The overgrown footpath has been cleared of undergrowth but it is still not clear who wll be responsible or its maintenance once the development is complete.

Action: Clerk to contact Bucks Council to check who they believe will be responsible for the public footpath.

- The hedge along Little Marsh bordering the Site A development still had not been cut back Action: Clerk to remind W.E. Black to get the hedge cut back

7.4.2 Site B

It was noted that the Shop and Post Office located on Site B (Berry Close) are now open and councillors were impressed with it.

It is not clear who will be responsible for the pond on the development.

Action: Clerk to contact Deanfield Homes to enquire who will be responsible for the maintenance of the pond. [Clerk's note: Deanfield Homes have confirmed that the maintenance of the pond will be the responsibility of the management company.]

8 CLERK'S REPORT

8.1 Finance Report

Clerk presented the Financial Report for October 2022. Payments totalling £4959.93 were approved, as detailed in appendix 2

8.2 Bank Mandate

Clerk confirmed that:

- Cllrs RC and JS are now signatories on the Parish Council account.
- She still is battling with Barclays Bank regarding the ID verification it has requested and will make an appointment with Barclays to try to resolve the problem.

8.3 Finance Meeting

It was agreed that a Finance Meeting will be held at 8pm on Tuesday 1 November to review the FY to November and project to March 2023 to set the budget to enable the precept to be set.

9 PUBLIC PARTICIPATION (CARRIED ON FROM 5 ABOVE)

Chair invited the resident present to speak who raised the following issues:

The resident reported that:

- i. Bucks Council have abdicated their responsibility for the maintenance of the churchyard which now falls onto the parish. Following a meeting of the PCC the resident requested help from the Parish Council for the cost of repair of the wall which needs pointing. The PCC plan to get a local workman to carry out the work but have not yet got a quotation.
- ii. Cars parking on Station Road are exacerbating the problem in that passing vehicles, especially lorries, are having to get closer and closer to the wall resulting in the road pushing up towards the wall (a site meeting 40 years ago suggested that the road should be widened and pushed away from the church wall but this was never carried through)
- iii. Residents are concerned about the parking opposite the shop.
- iv. Is it possible to get traffic lights installed at the Blackthorn Bridge?
- v. The kissing gate at Ham Pond is broken and he suggested that a gate could be transferred from one area where it is not needed.
- vi. Residents had requested a bridge across Ham Pond as residents are getting their feet wet in bad weather.
- vii. Claimed that the recent road improvement work on Heet Road was an environment disaster with an increase in traffic and the loss of some important heritage.

In response to the above Councillors noted that:

i. The maintenance of the church yard is not the responsibility of the Parish Council. The Parish Council believes that it had opted out of this responsibility in 2010 but were looking into this again.
Action: Clerk will liaise with Cllr PE and David Evershed to look into this further.

ii. The Parish Council had requested Thames Valley Police (TVP) to visit the area and had been advised that TVP would arrange for their Traffic Wardens to monitor the area but Council believe that this has not happened. It was agreed that those who do park on Station Road should be made aware of the problems they are causing.

Action: Clerk to follow up with TVP

- iii. The Parish Council is working with Bucks Council to improve the safety of the area opposite the shop.
- iv. The Parish Council will contact Blackthorn Parish Council and Oxfordshire Council to ask if there any plans for traffic lights to be installed and if not to try to start the process to get them installed.
- v. Chair will raise this with the owner of the field to check that he is happy for the gate to be transferred (Note: the resident offered to carry out the work if approval is given.)
- vi. Chair will organise a site meeting to decide on the way forward to install a bridge across Ham Pond.

Resident left the meeting at 9pm.

10 VALE OF AYLESBURY LOCAL PLAN (VALP)/MARSH GIBBON NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN (NP)

10.1 Marsh Gibbon Neighbourhood Plan

Cllrs agreed to monitor information regarding the update of the Neighbourhood Plan.

11 REPORT FROM VILLAGE HALL

11.1 Report

There were no updates.

11.2 Car Park

Bucks Council have authorised the release of up to £36,000 (including VAT) from planning application 17/01248/AOP on production of invoices for the village hall car park work.

12 PLAY EQUIPMENT, TEENAGE RECREATION AREA AND RECREATION GROUND

12.1 Maintenance

Cllr RC had met with Technical Surfaces to discuss the maintenance and repairs of the all weather pitch. Technical Surfaces explained how the maintenance plan we have in place will prolong the life of the astroturf and recommended that this stay in place. The additional quotes are for repairs to patch any holes which are in addition to the maintenance taking place.

A current approximate figure for a new surface is £25K to £35K.

12.2 Playground Upgrade

The post installation inspection had taken place and recommendations are being implemented. Cllrs RC and NL are ensuring that safety fencing is in place until all the work is complete. Cllr RC has the fixing of a replacement gate in hand.

Cllr NL will liaise with FCC and Bucks Council (S106 from planning application 07/01493/APP) for payment of grants once the invoices are received.

The old bench, donated by the Women's Institute, will be removed.

Action: Cllr NL try to find out who would like the plaque from the bench.

It was suggested that the opening of the new playground should be held on the same date as the opening of the Jubilee Plantation – see 21 below.

Action: Cllr RC to ask his wife (a school governor) to liaise with Greg Smith, MP.

13 DEVOLVED SERVICES

It was noted that following a report to Fix My Street regarding the condition of the Hedgeside Path an inspection by TfB reported that "We have unfortunately been unable to locate an issue at the location plotted on the map." .

14 ROADS AND PATHWAYS

14.1 Potholes / Road repairs

No new potholes were reported.

14.2 Parking in Castle Street

Deanfield Homes have in hand the work on the road narrowing outside the school following the issue of the report from Bucks Council. A misunderstanding that the school head needed to "sign off" the work has been resolved.

14.3 Speeding

Speeding in all parts of the village continues to be an issue. Cllr TR reported that he had received approval from Thames Valley Police for various locations to hold the Speedwatch. However, it was disappointing that only one person had come forward to volunteer. Until more volunteers are available it won't be possible to hold the Speedwatch.

15 STREET LIGHTING

15.1 Maintenance

The following street lights were reported not to be working:

- Plough end of Acland Terrace: however, it was noted that tree branches need cutting back
- Thompkins Lane: it was noted that the tree has now been cut back
- Opposite the Plough

Action: Clerk to report to E.on.

16 CEMETERY MATTERS

16.1 General Maintenance

16.1.2 Following the very dry weather, the grave digger had filled in some graves that had split and would continue to fill in the remainder as necessary.

16.1.3 The seat in the arbour needs cleaning.

Action: Cllr RC to erect "bird deterrent".

16.2 Burial, Interments, Advance booking requests and Memorial applications

16.2.1 **Burials**

A burial had taken place in Grave space D-1-13.

16.2.2 Advance reservation

Reservations had been made for grave spaces D-1-14, D-1-15 and D-3-2.

Action: Cllr TR to place the reservation slabs on the respective grave spaces and clerk to obtain slabs as required.

16.2.3 Grave Spaces

It was agreed that only 15 graves per row should be allocated in Section D as councillors were concerned that tree roots might interfere with additional spaces.

16.3 Cemetery Road

Cllr PE reported that all the roads within the cemetery had now split and she was looking into getting professional advice on the way forward. It was noted that the £5,000 earmarked in the budget may not be enough to cover the cost of repair work.

Following the decision to get the Poplar trees felled over three years, it was subsequently agreed that they should be felled over two. The cost to fell three trees this year is £2122.50+VAT.

16.4 Seating

Following the addition of Section D into the cemetery it was agreed that two seats should be added to the cemetery financed from S106 funds.

Action: Clerk to start the process to get the funding and once approved, order the seats.

17 ENVIRONMENTAL MATTERS

17.1 Ware Pond

It was noted that East West Rail will not be cleaning out Ware Pond. It was agreed that the contractor who previously did the work will be asked. It was hoped to get this work completed before the Christmas Tree is erected on 3 December.

Action: Chair to speak to resident to arrange for the work to be completed.

18 STREET FURNITURE

No updates were available.

19 COMMUNITY BOARD

No updates were available.

20 CHRISTMAS TREE

The Christmas Tree would be delivered at 7.30am on Saturday 3 December, for erection by volunteers starting at 9.30am. Cllr PE confirmed that she is liaising with volunteers.

A resident had queried whether there would be a Christmas Tree this year due to the increasing electricity costs. It was noted that last year's electricity cost was £9.75 including VAT and that the tree would go ahead to bring "some good cheer" to the village.

21 JUBILEE PLANTATION

Chair thanked Cllrs RC, TR and NL for the work they did to reinforce the stock fencing to make it safe for the school children to visit. It also was noted that the School Head had invited Greg Smith MP to formally open the planatation on 11 November.

Action: Chair and Cllr RC agreed to invite two previous councillors, Ian Metherell and Richard Cross Snr to the event.

22 BOUNDARY COMMISSION

The Claydons had requested that Steeple Claydon should remain in the Grendon Underwood Ward and that there should be two, not one Councillors, for this Ward. Before supporting this, councillors required further information on how this would effect Marsh Gibbon.

Action: Clerk to make enquiries

23 ANY OTHER BUSINESS

23.1 Post Office

Cllr ET has sent flowers to the lady who had been running the out-reach Post Office as a thank you.
